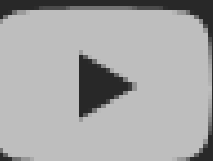

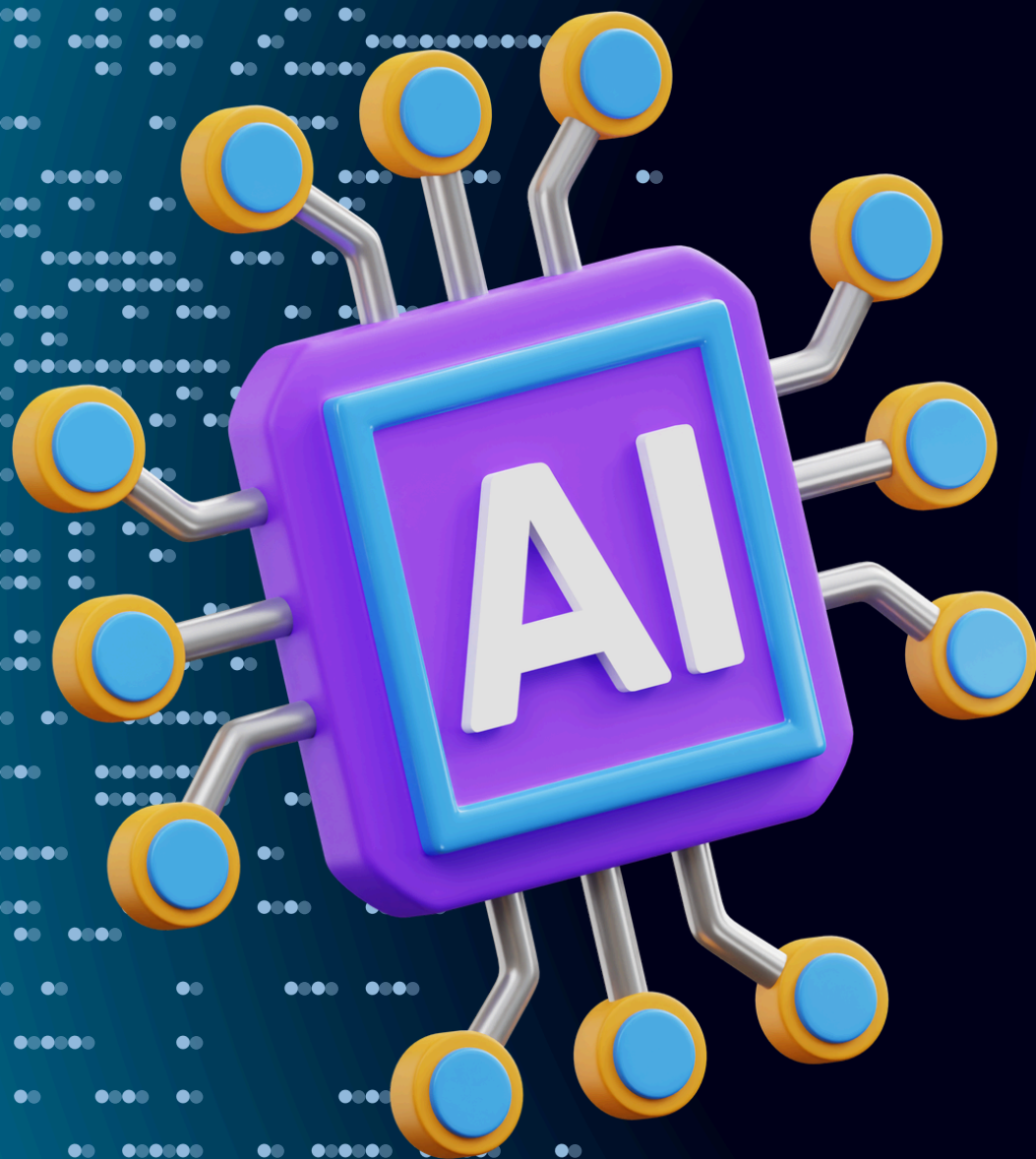

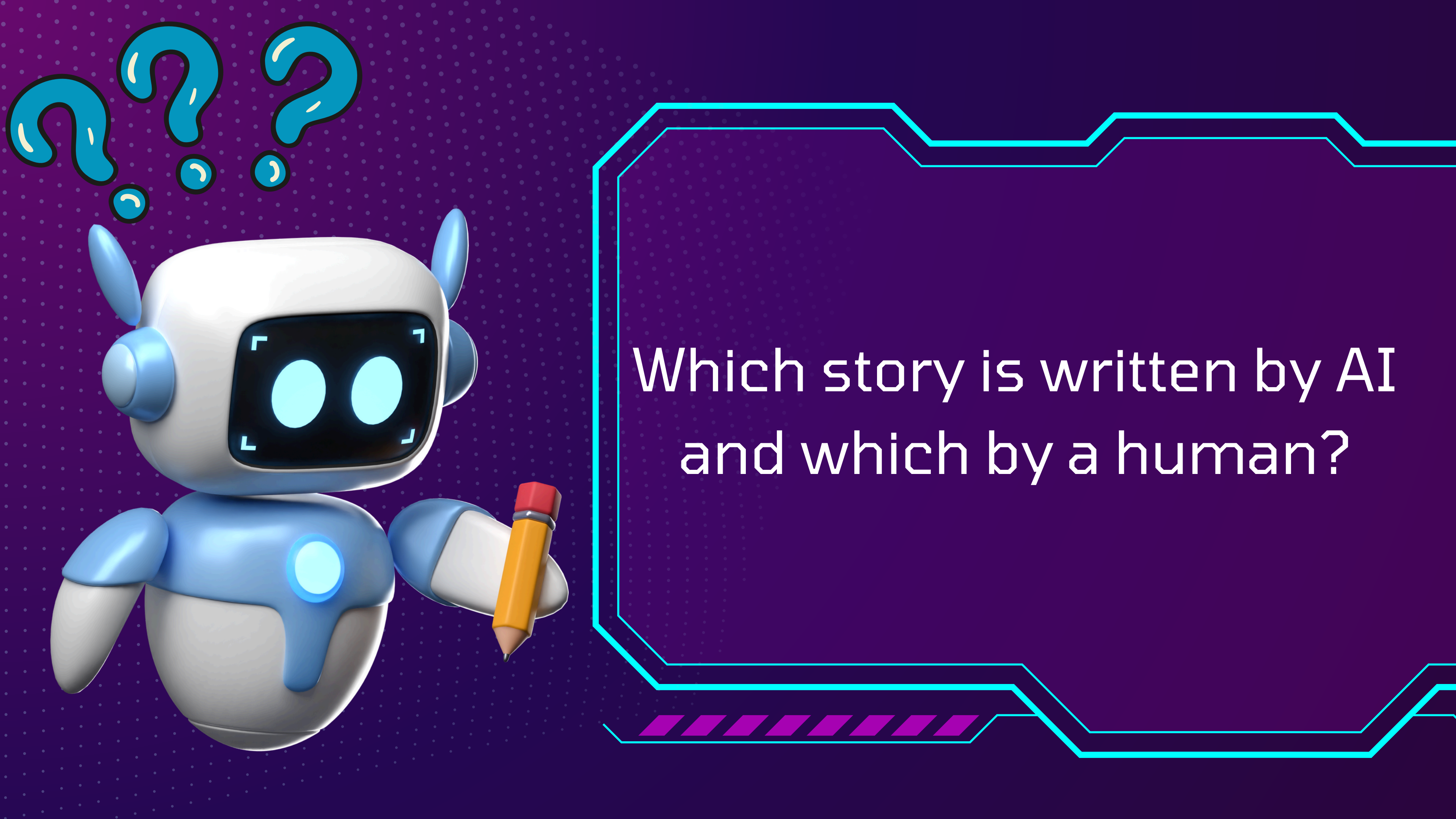


# Important Vocabulary

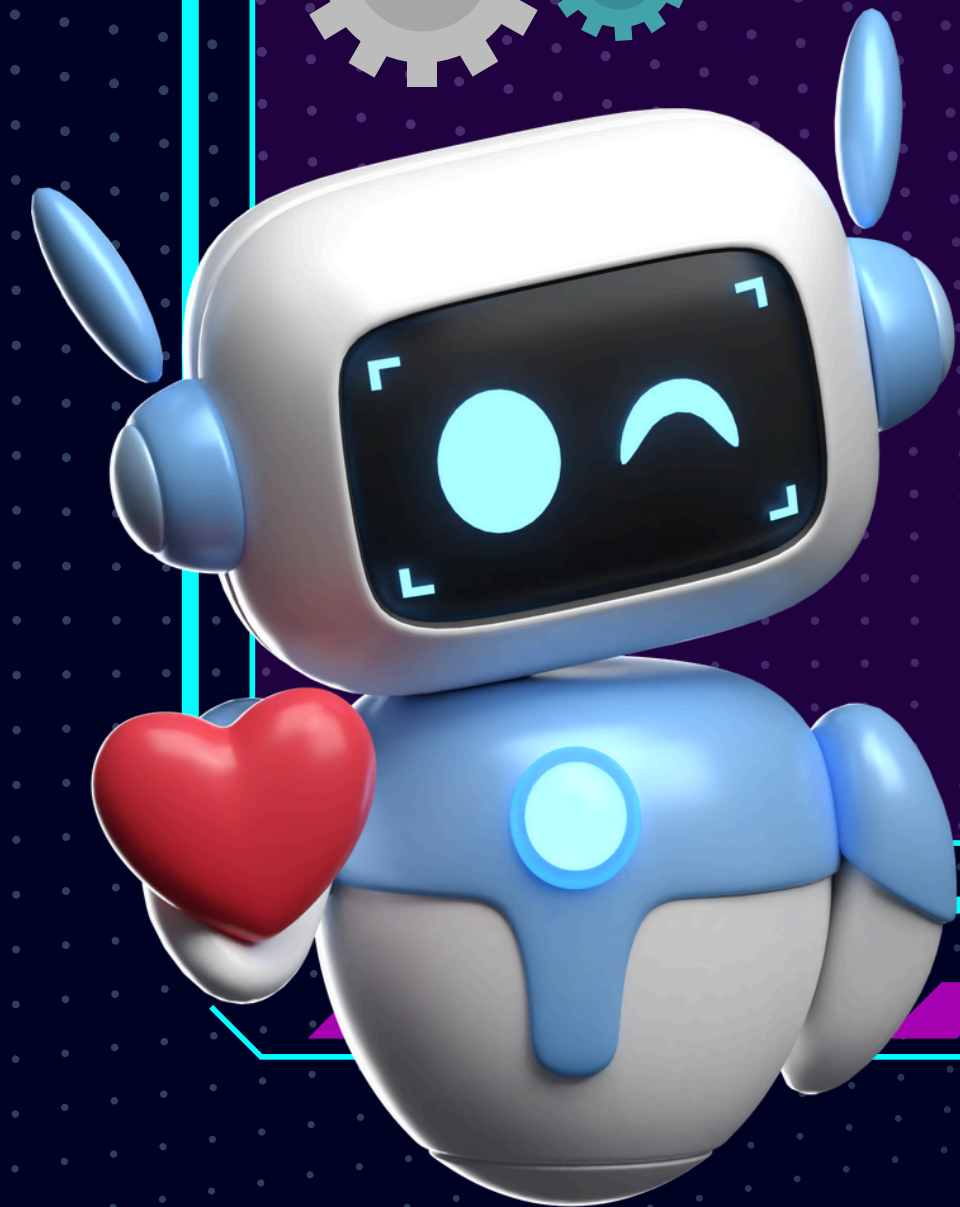
## Story 1:

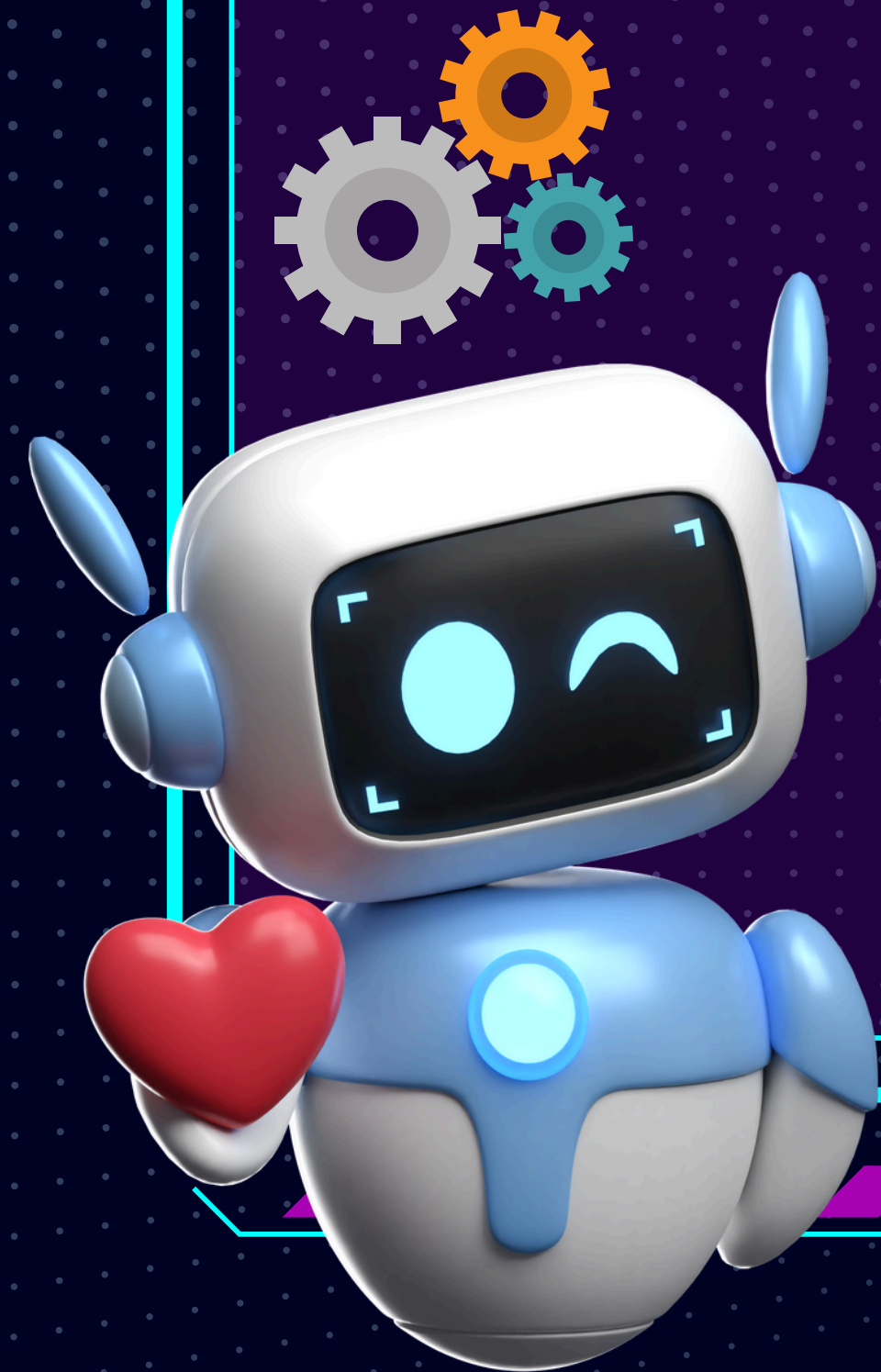
## Story 2:
